## **Physical Access**

Edel Assanti has a step-free entrance suitable for wheelchair users. The entrance is located at 44 Mortimer Street, **not** our main entrance at 1B Little Titchfield Street. As you enter the building there is a raised lip as part of the door frame which is 10 cm off the ground. The width of the entrance is 85cm. The narrowest access point on our ground floor has a width of 107.5cm. Visitors should be aware that there are 4 steps upon entering the main entrance to the gallery.

Sometimes visitors may be required to queue while waiting for an event. If queuing is not accessible for you or a member of your party please get in touch so we can make alternative arrangements.

Assistance animals are always very welcome.

## **Seating**

We are able to provide folding chairs to any visitors who may need to sit down regularly. Please ask the member of staff at the front desk, who will be happy to assist.

## **Toilets and baby changing**

The gallery does not have public toilets or baby changing facilities. The closest facility is across the road at Riding House Cafe, 43-51 Great Titchfield St. London W1W 7PQ.
